# **PROGRAM NOTES**

Thank you for coming to hear our concert tonight; I believe you are in for a real treat. Both of these pieces have a feeling of celebration about them. As we begin a new century and a new millenium, I want to do so in a jubilant, joyful manner.

The Lord Nelson Mass was named in honor of the great British admiral Horatio Nelson, best known for his victory at Trafalgar and for the square bearing that name in the centre of London. Haydn was a great admirer of Nelson and it is highly likely that Nelson would have heard this piece performed during his lifetime. The whole piece is lively and makes much use of the musical equivalent to the literary term Sturm und Drang (Storm and Stress). This refers to the strong and sudden changes of dynamics that you will hear throughout. As always, the chorale has risen to the challenge of the solo sections, which are none too easy.

The second piece is John Rutter's Gloria. We are joined by brass for this performance and I am especially grateful to the performers for their time and energy. The work is quite stunning: driving, restless, engaging, reflective at times, but permeated with a sense of exuberance. This twentieth century setting breathes new life into the nearly 2000 year-old texts and keeps the choir on its toes as well!

Finally, I am very grateful to the singers of the Flint Hills Masterworks Chorale. Their hard work and commitment make my job all the more rewarding. I hope you enjoy our presentation.

### Kyrie

Even to the Lord God shall they cry, but he shall not hear them. Thou shall deliver me from the strivings of the people. Lord, thy name is worthy to be praised above all Gods. For thine is the kingdom and the power, and the glory, forevermore.

### Et resurrexit

Thou has maintained my right and my cause. Lord, thou has put out their name for ever, and all they that know thy name will put their trust in thee. Thou has never failed them that seek thee, for thy word shall endure forevermore. O Lord, break thou the power of the ungodly and malicious; take away his ungodliness, and thou shalt find none. For he hath rebelled against thee. Lord, let not my fores triumph over me. Stretch forth thy hand against mine enemies. The Lord is my shield and my buckler, and my heart hath trusted in him; therefore shall I never be confounded. Sing praises and bless his glorious name, Amen.

### Benedictus

He is blessed that cometh, O Lord, in thy holy name. Hosanna in the highest.

Hallelujah, Amen.
