Gloria by Poulenc

The son of a wealthy family of pharmaceutical manufacturers in France, Francis Poulenc was a composer and a pianist. He wrote his first published composition, *Rapsodie nègre*, in 1918, and was considered to be a member of Les Six. As a result of the death of a friend in 1935, he returned to his Roman Catholic faith, and thereafter wrote a steady flow of sacred choral works. He composed *Gloria* in 1959.

Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to men of good will.

Laudamus te

We praise thee, we bless thee, we adore thee, we glorify thee, we give thee thanks for thy great glory.

Domine Deus

Lord God, heavenly King, God the Father almighty.

O Lord Jesus Christ, the only-begotten Son.

Dominus Deus, Agnus Dei

Lord God, Lamb of God, Son of the Father, who takes away the sins of the world, have mercy upon us. Who takes away the sins of the world, receive our prayer.

Qui sedes ad dexteram Patris

He who sits at the right hand of the Father, have mercy on us. For thou only art holy, Thou only art Lord. Thou only art most high, Jesus Christ, together with the Holy Ghost, in the glory of God the Father. Amen.
